According to the World Health Organization, "Blood transfusion saves lives and improves health, but many patients requiring transfusion DO NOT HAVE timely access to safe blood."



To address this need, the four Rotary Clubs of Dumaguete under Area 1G, with the Rotary Club of Dumaguete East as the lead club, in collaboration with the Rotaract Club of Silliman University and the Philippine Red Cross Negros Oriental Chapter, conducted the project, "Drop of Hope" on July 12, 2025, from 9AM-12NN at the Philippine Red Cross Negros Oriental Chapter Office, Dumaguete City.

"Drop of Hope" is an area-wide bloodletting and medical services activity of the Rotary Club Area 1-G. All Rotary clubs of Dumaguete unite for good; hand in hand, they prioritize health and saving lives.

Leading the program of the event were District Assistant Governor Ran Lim and RCDE President Eric Bulos.



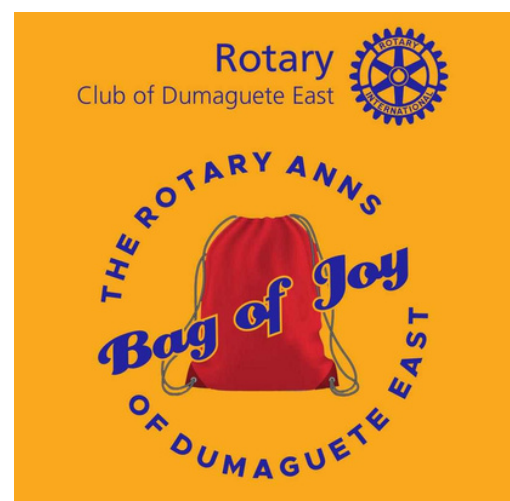
