This year’s school supplies included bond paper, pencils, sharpeners, rulers, crayons, colored paper, writing pads, and envelopes—all aimed at supporting both students’ learning and teachers’ classroom needs.

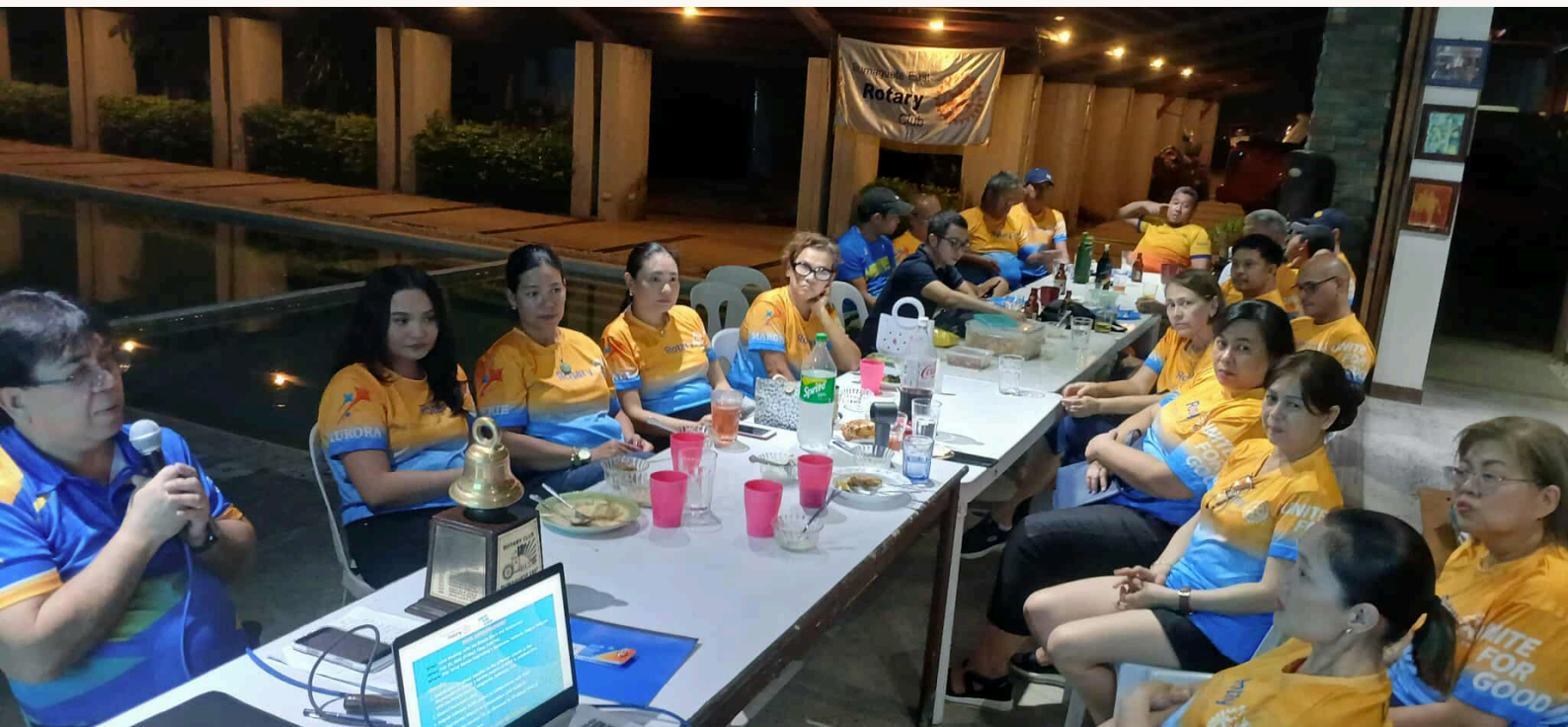
