

Maybe it was because he had so many relatives, Piñero being a very big family in Dumaguete, so he calls most people as "agaw".

It was in 1989 or 1990 when I first met "En-en", during the IBP election of officers at the Boy Scout Building. In that election, Atty. Llosa was elected as President, while both Atty. Piñero and I were elected as among the five (5) IBP Directors. Since that time, our friendship developed, as we saw each other every IBP activity. And we shared the same "pastimes" like mahjong and sabong. We started going together in our "pastimes" and on our pleasure trips, rarely missing any cockfight derbies anywhere in the province. We even ended up travelling to other provinces just to attend to the bigtime derbies.

Despite all our pleasure trips and "pastimes", we always attended to our clients and cases. We have even collaborated as lawyers in some cases. And "En-en" had always remained a good Christian and Samaritan. Every December, he used to give me a "Daily Bread" diary, containing important and assuring scriptures from the Bible.

Then sometime in 2009 or 2010, we joined the ROTARY CLUB OF DUMAGUETE NORTH, where we both became Presidents. Before this covid-19 pandemic, we used to hold our meetings from Friday to Saturday --- the meeting starts on a Friday and ends on a Saturday morning. We had enjoyed together our meetings, where we plan various projects for the community – and of course, the fellowships after every meeting, where we simultaneously start to talk, drink and sing...

"Agaw En-en" had a golden voice and really loved to sing. He also enjoyed dancing with his wife Debra – and they were such a beautiful couple. He lived a good and wonderful life – enjoyed the company of friends and family. He was a contented man who loved his family so much. His concern for his family (his wife Debra, children Cathy, Andy and Tantoy and his grandchildren) always came first.

And then one night, I received a call from our close friends, telling me that "agaw En-en" was in the emergency room of the Silliman Medical Center. I immediately went to the hospital where I saw "agaw En-en" fighting for his life. From that moment on, we all missed the company of "agaw En-en" – he became bed-ridden for almost 19 months --- until last August 27, he passed away...

"Agaw En-en", you will sadly be missed but will certainly be fondly remembered --- thank you for everything... thank you for your friendship... rest in peace now...












Soon after taking up cycling, Jeff noticed a significant change to his body
