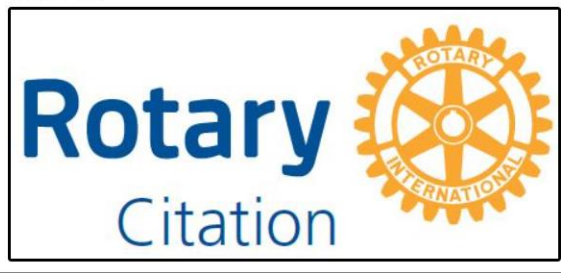

"Wow! That's a very expensive classic car. What's so bad about that?"

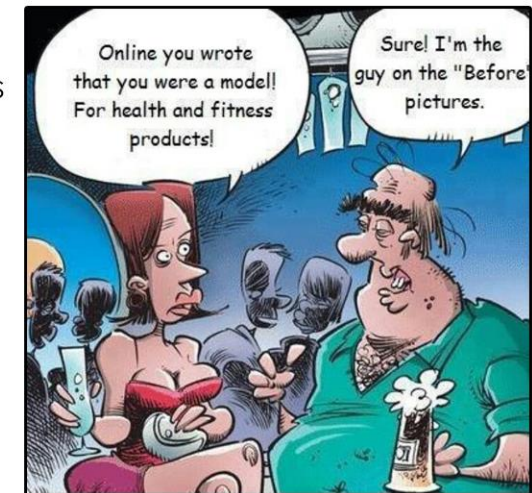

- Find experts who can help make your projects more effective and

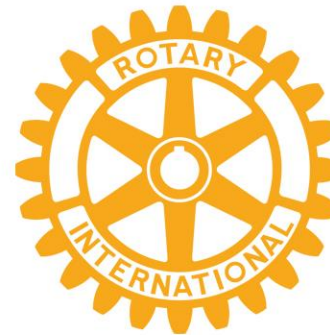
sustainable by connecting with one of the Rotary Action Groups that focuses on promoting peace:
