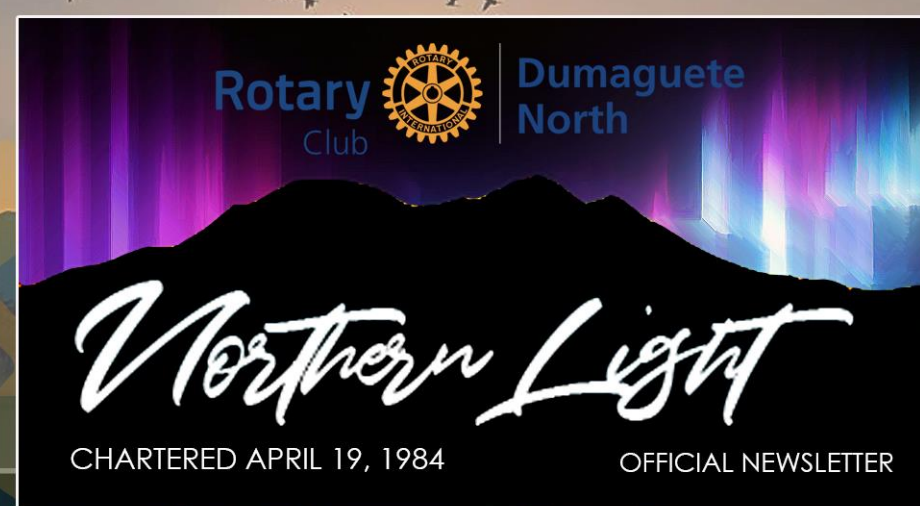

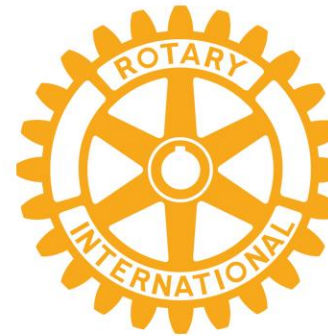
Figuring the man wouldn't see anything, they open the door.
