

I can recall that during consultations with clients, more particularly about criminal or civil cases, I find myself looping in the majority of these meetings the same philosophical subject matter–actual truth vs. judicial truth.

On one hand, "actual" truth is what really occurred. This is what the universe knows to be true. On the other hand "judicial" truth is something that you can prove in court, with whatever evidence you have in relation to the evidence of the other party. As a lawyer, I want proof and evidence from my client. Often times, judicial truth does not always square-up with actual truth.

A very important trait of Rotary is community service. I partake in community service activities with the group; and I feel as if I am a charitable or helpful person. However, I began to think: what about my individual daily interactions with the needy. Do I help when no one is looking? Do I aid when it cannot be proven to others?

For me, this is one aspect that Rotary strives to do— to not only encourage us to perform these good deeds for the community, which we get will recognized for, but also to practice this same sense of goodwill and service as individuals, during our daily interactions, without any recognition or proof of goodwill whatsoever. I hope that I can be a person that acts with goodwill and service to others, not because I can prove it and get recognition for it, but because it is simply the actual truth.
