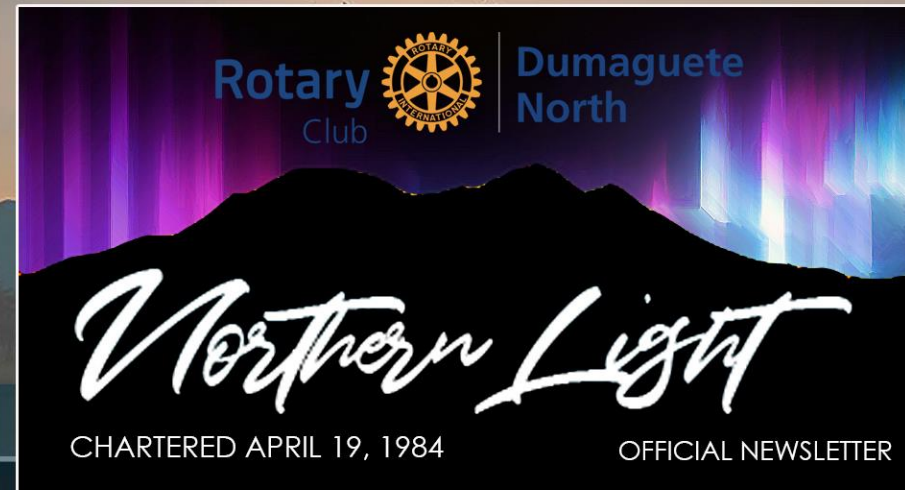

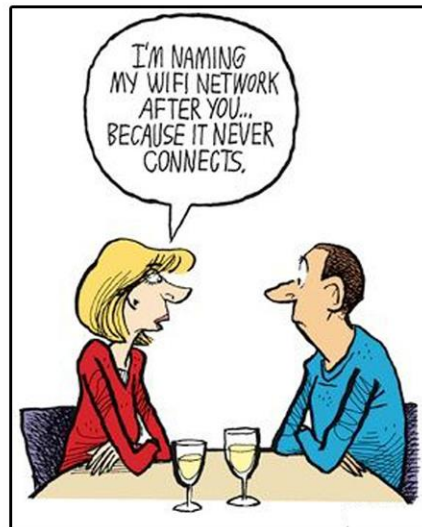

cherished goal.

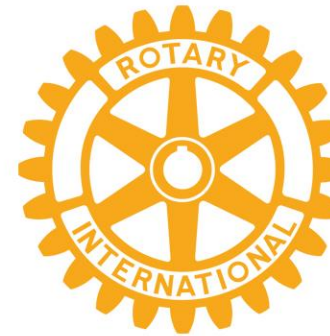
REFRAIN: With the Four Way Test
