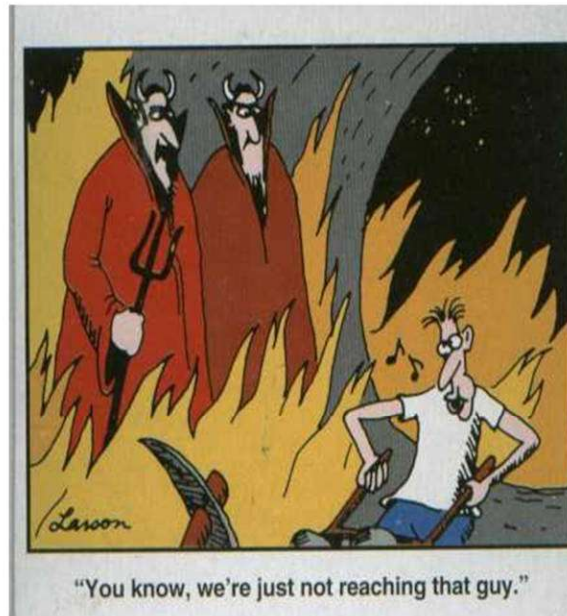
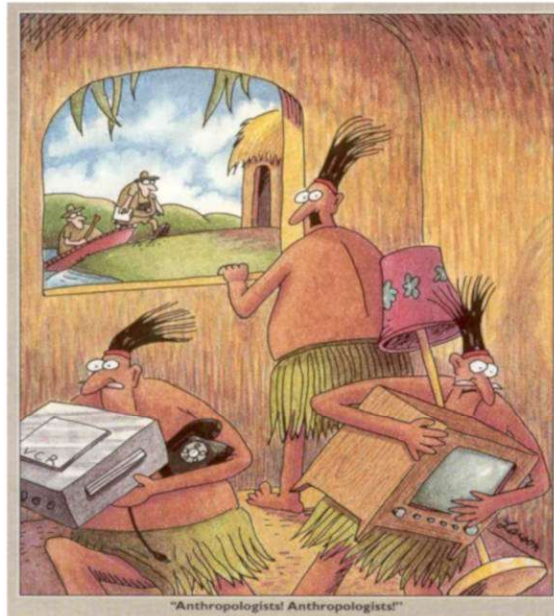

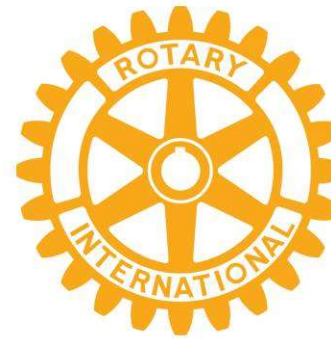
I want to be a Rotarian for the world
