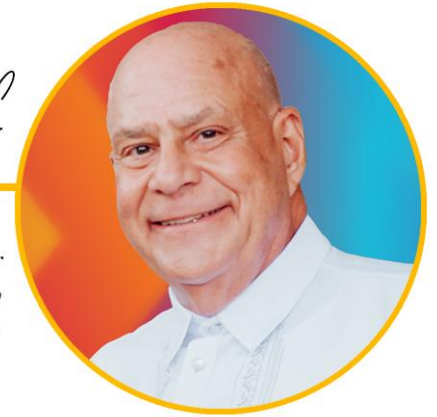

The motto "Service Above Self" came out of a conversation between two Rotarians during the 1911 National Rotary Convention in Portland, Oregon. It was officially adopted by Rotary in 1950 at the Rotary International Convention in Detroit, MI and it has brought people together in a common purpose to create a better world, every day, ever since.

As a Rotarian, "Service Above Self" is a personal commitment to put the needs of others before your own and to do your part to improve the community you live in.

Last Saturday, I witnessed Rotarians rolling up their sleeves (so to speak) and putting service above self. I was not only impressed with their dedication to make a difference in their community, but also uplifted by their cheerful fellowship as they dug, raked, swept, scraped, primed and painted.

It is true that "We are greater when we look beyond ourselves and when we do for others, it is our purpose." The power of purpose was palpable on Saturday. We all felt it.

Paul Harris, the Founder of Rotary International, got it right when he said "Whatever Rotary may mean to us, to the world it will be known by the results it achieves." And the results of our efforts on Saturday at the school not only improved our community in appearance and health, but also helped, as we say, to "build a bridge for tomorrow's youth". Well done Rotarians! I'm proud to be a "Rotarian for the World".

ROTARY FACTS

**Did you know it took 78 years for Rotary to accept women members?**

That's correct, it took until 1989 when RI constitutional change was made at the Council on Legislation, with a vote to eliminate the "male only" provision for Rotary.

In 1911 women only clubs existed in Minneapolis and in Minnesota alongside the men's club. Then, in 1918, the RI Board changed the constitution to state that Rotary membership was for "males only."

## ENTERTAINMENT CORNER

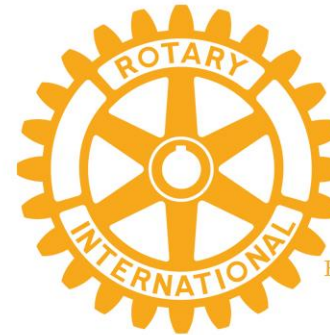
