This success is not just a reflection of our individual efforts, but a testament to what we can achieve when we work together with a common purpose.

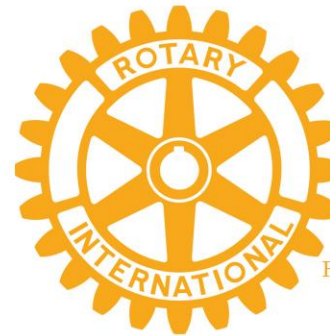
