RANDOM THOUGHTS ON THE FOUR-WAY TEST

Reading the four-way test every meeting is, and should be, a solemn experience. Not like just a routinary recital of a nursery rhyme. The words we utter should sink deep into our hearts. It should be a constant reminder for us to reflect on our daily actions, thoughts, and words.

Nobody's perfect. This is the first undeniable truth. Each of us has his or her own baggage of untruths, misdeeds, or wrongdoings perhaps hidden under our sleeves. How close (or how far) we are from the ideals of truth, fairness, goodwill, and beneficiality may only differ in degree and extent. So each day must be a struggle to overcome such imperfections in order to become new and better persons, bringing ourselves closer to the ideals of our four-way mantra. My daily goal for instance, is to change bits and pieces of undesirable traits or habits in me, trying hard to make myself a better person than I was the day before. Little conquests each day already mean a lot. Sometimes little or nothing is accomplished. But the persistence is there. For indeed, the greatest conquest of all is the conquest of one's self.

But any change for the better must start with an honest awareness and humble acceptance of one's self in all aspects, both the good and the ugly. To realize our mistakes, to identify our weaknesses & limitations is the first step of the

process. It takes a lot of humility to do this, because more often than not, false pride gets in the way and we tend to justify our mistakes. False pride is blind adherence to self-preservation at any and all cost, even at the expense of truth and friendship. Sometimes one knowingly asserts the untrue or deliberately twists the truth, to suit his selfish ends. The usual lame justification is: "Well, I have an image to preserve, a reputation to protect".

Yet our faith tells us that there is more honor to the sinner who humbly beats his chest with bowed head asking for forgiveness, than the one who grandstands in public to camouflage evil deeds. Without humility, efforts towards self-improvement would be pointless. In every incident involving a conflict with a brother, it is prudent to take a moment of reflection at the height of anger or frustration to objectively evaluate the issue causing the conflict. Anger and false pride only worsen the conflict. Before pointing an accusing finger, try first to evaluate your own thoughts, words, and deeds. In doing so, you might realize when the dust settles that you

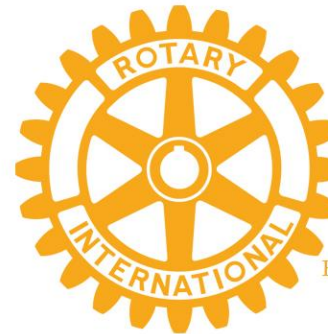
De Camargo plans to boost Rotary's public image by working from the top down.
