ALTHOUGH ROTARY INTERNATIONAL and Rotary Clubs throughout the Philippines and discuss their commitment to *Diversity, Equity and Inclusion (DEI)*, is it really a reality?

District 3860 is comprised of over 100 Rotary Clubs, 23 Areas and 2,779 members, which of course is subject to fluctuations.

Being a foreigner in the Philippines and a caucasian of course, I would be considered a subject of such tenets. After proudly being selected to be the Rotary Club Dumaguete North Secretary-Elect, I attended the 2023 PETS/SETS in Butan City.

I was surprised, a little shocked and somewhat disappointed when I reviewed the roster of attendees and discovered that I was the only foreigner of more than 200 Rotarians. Of course, that was primarily the President-Elects and Secretary-Elects of all the clubs. It was somewhat better, but minimal improvement during the DTA/DISTAS in Bohol.

I have reviewed some randomly selected clubs in the district and it strongly appear that currently, Diversity, Equity and Inclusion seems to be primarily regarding women.

I must commend the Rotary Club Dumaguete North for its outstanding commitment to Diversity by the very fact of including foreigners of other races, not only as members but as board members, presidents and secretaries -- including them in the decision making of events that involved every aspect of the club.

When foreigners visit, they invariably ask for introductions as to how the foreigners are treated in our club. I can honestly say that the brothers have never made me feel different or unaccepted in any way. I even no longer think about it. RCDN has truly displayed Diversity, Equity and Inclusion. We have wonderful membership of open minded and committed brothers and I thank the club for inviting me to be part of it.
