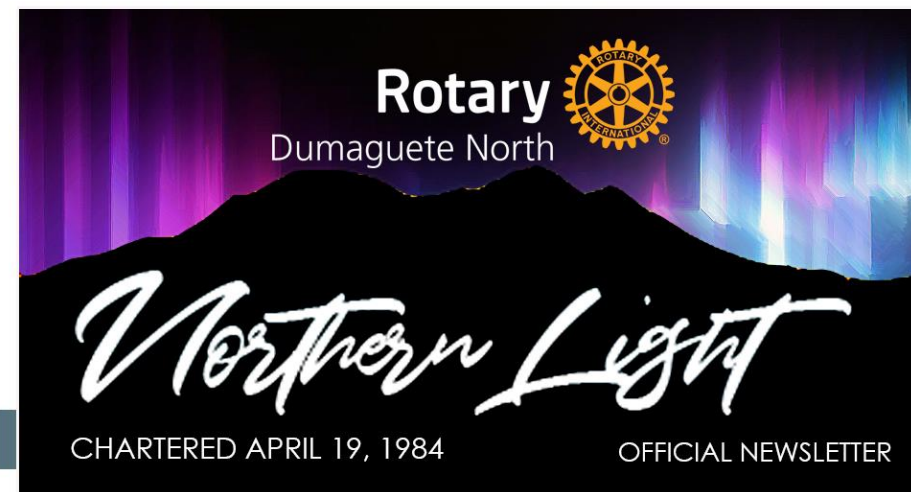

One of those areas of focus is Protecting the Environment. So far, off the top of my head, the projects that we have accomplished dealing with the environment are Tree/Mangrove Planting and selective area wide cleanups. Of course, this does not include some of the indirect beneficial effects to the environment when performing some of our other projects dealing with other areas of focus. So we should definitely be proud of what we have accomplished so far as a group.



Currently, a potential environmental protection project that the Board of Directors are contemplating is project that will help either protect or aid in the propagation of our Coral Reefs in the Philippines, specifically in the Negros Oriental area. Many wonder why the protection and growth of coral reefs is important to local communities and the public at large.

As per a recent article I read on *scuba.com*:

maintaining marine and supporting various marine life. In addition, these reefs are natural barriers, protecting coastlines from storms, erosion, flooding, and safe guarding human communities. They also serve as nurseries for various fish species, sustaining fish industries, which is a significant food source for the local communities.

Moreover, these reefs contribute to carbon and nutrient cycling, which helps regulate the global climate and quality of water.

Indirectly, these beautiful habitants boost tourism, generating economic benefits for coastal communities. You can see this play out with many of our coastal municipalities such as the Municipality of Dauin.

Being in a coastal province, you can see why maintaining this precious feature of nature should be an area of focus when dealing with projects aiding in the protection of our local environment; and such is the reason why we as a club should endeavor in pursuing this very type of service project. 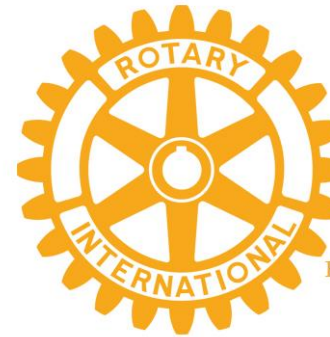
