## Random Lenten Reflections

IN THIS LENTEN Season, the Christian world commemorates the passion, death, and resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ. Allow me to share a few points of reflection.

The Apostles who followed Jesus never imagined the gruesome death that awaited their Master as they entered Jerusalem. They expected Jesus to use His powers and bring all His persecutors to their knees. But they were disappointed, appalled, and even scared by the turn of events. Jesus was scourged, tortured, and led to his death, but He remained meek and humble, like a lamb led to the slaughter house. What is more baffling for them is the first of his seven last words. Hanging from the cross and nearing death, Jesus exclaimed: "Father, forgive them for they do not know not what they do!"

*Forgiveness.*

This to me, is the most profound but most challenging message in Lent. "*Forgive those who sinned against you, and pray for those*

*who calumniate you,*" Jesus said to his disciples. He lived and died on these words. He did not lift as much as a finger against his torturers. At the peak of his bodily suffering, he still had the heart to forgive. And His forgiveness were not mere lip service, the words came straight from the heart - unconditional love even for the enemies.

Humans who dare to follow Jesus are always faced with this difficult challenge. More often, when others hurt or injure us, the instant human reaction is to get even, to meet force by force. Some even retaliate with more violence. It is easy to say "I'm sorry" and often under many conditions. Thus, if the words do not come from the heart, forgiveness is meaningless. When we learn to forgive from the heart, that is the only time when we can truly say we are followers of Jesus Christ.

As we move forward together, let us continue to embody the spirit of Rotary and strive for excellence in all that we do. Together, we can achieve great things.

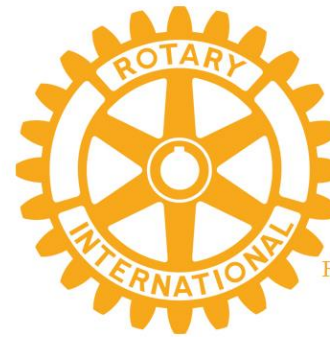
