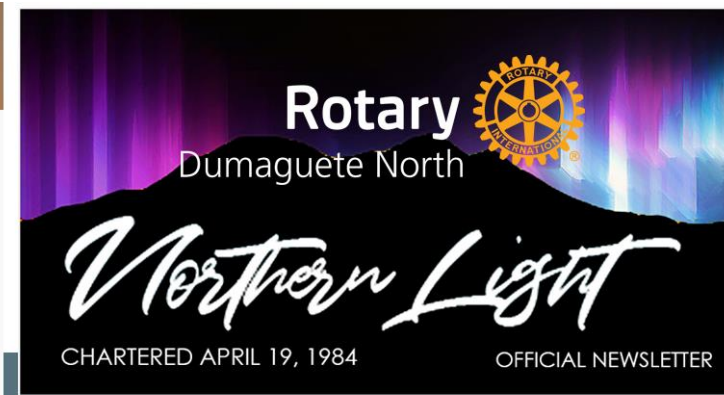

## WHO IS A PAUL HARRIS FELLOW?

A **Paul Harris Fellow (PHF)** is a person who has been recognized as having done something significant for others. The Rotary Foundation recognizes them for the contribution of **\$US1,000**. The Rotary Foundation is a non-profit corporation that supports the efforts of Rotary International to achieve world understanding and peace through international humanitarian, educational, and cultural exchange programs. It is supported solely by voluntary contributions from Rotarians and friends of the Foundation who share its vision of a better world.

In 1957, the idea of Paul Harris Fellow (PHF) recognition was first proposed as a means to promote voluntary giving to the Rotary Foundation. The PHF Pin and Certificate have become highly respected symbols of a substantial commitment to The Rotary Foundation by Rotarians and friends around the world.

The companion to the Paul Harris Fellow is the Paul Harris Sustaining Member (PH/SM) which is the recognition presented to an individual who has given, or in

whose honor a gift is made, a minimum contribution of \$100/year, with the intention of making additional contributions until \$1,000 is reached. Rotary Clubs may also donate \$US1,000 to the Rotary Foundation on behalf of a non-Rotarian in recognition of that person's significant contribution to the Community. On the other hand *The Paul Harris Society* recognizes a contribution of \$1,000 or more every year.

The Recognition is named for Paul Harris, the founder of Rotary International.

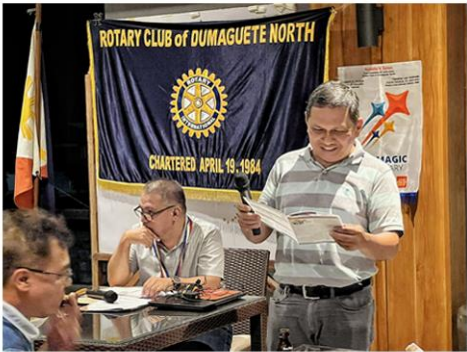
