organizations, especially those new or unaware to Rotary and its core values. Another reason is for Rotarians to contemplate the impact of their actions on everyone and everything else.

One of the primary synonyms of the word fair is the word equal. However, if you really think about it fairness and quality are not always the same thing. While equality of opportunity is a cornerstone of fairness, it rarely exists.

I don't think our projects directly places persons or communities in need on equal footing with other persons or communities. However, what our projects do accomplish is to help create or balance out the opportunity for those in needs. It is important for us to understand and realize that equal opportunity does not always lead to equal outcomes.

If you think about a typical 800 meter race with a starting line and finishing line, there is a difference with helping a weaker runner by training him or her to do better at racing compared to allowing the weaker runner to start 400 meters ahead of everyone else. Remember that the whole maxim is: is it fair to all concerned.
