We provide service to others, promote integrity, and advance world understanding, goodwill, and peace through our fellowship of business, professional, and community leaders.

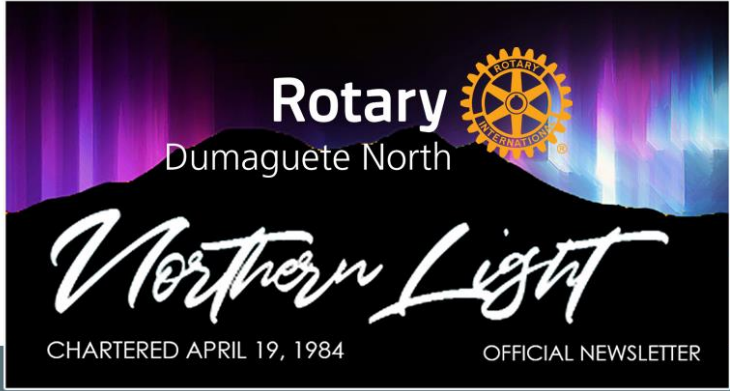
## VISION STATEMENT

All about citronella

Citronella (*Cymbopogon nardus*) is a plant similar to lemon grass. If planted exposed to sunlight and with proper care, it will produce 20 to 30 sprouts in 2 to 3 months. It should not be planted near to a lemon grass as it easily be mistake as such. Several experiments have been conducted on the uses of citronella as it has be found to be an effective insect repellant, anti-fungal, anti-inflammatory, anti-bacteria, and safe to use -- no toxic effect.



Brother Max "Citronella" joined the Rotary Club of Dumaguete North as a retired Department of Agrarian , bringing in his expertise in agriculture and community development. One of his major contributions to RCDN is the club's citronella campaign for which the club has adopted as its Passion Project. As the current Community Service Director, he has organized various service projects in different schools and communities. Rtn. Max is currently the Club's President-Elect, set to be inducted as President in Rotary Year 2025-2026 under RID3860 Governor-Elect Jong Fernandez and RI President Mário César Martins de Camargo.

In Germany, citronella oil is mixed with candles to control mosquitos and flies while others mix citronella oil with virgin coconut oil for the same purpose. These products are commercially available in stores.

Citronella leaves can also be placed in a net bag, placed beside you in order to drive mosquitoes away. Boiled citronella leaves can be used in bathing dogs and other animals to prevent ticks and lice. It can also be placed under the chicken nest to prevent lice.

Boundaries of a certain lot in Maayongtubig, Dauinwere planted with citronella and no mosquitos or flies can be seen inside in the area. According to the owner, even snakes and frogs don't like the smell of citronella.

A few years ago, dengue was prevalent nationwide. Children were the most affected by the disease. There is a saying that, "Prevention is better than cure." This is the reason that the Rotary Club of Dumaguete North started the citronella information campaign and distribution to create awareness.

The club started propagating citronella and information campaign about dengue sometime in 2019. Since then, RCDN had made the Citronella Awareness Campaign and Distribution its Passion Project – focusing on the different elementary schools and communities in the Province of Negros Oriental.


