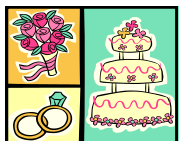

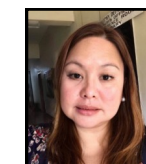

6. Impose violation to establishment that were not compliant to the environmental laws and policy;
