Recognition Amount: The total Plus Paul Harris Fellow recognition credited to an individual's account. Recognition may be achieved with one's personal contributions to the Foundation , a contribution made on behalf of the account holder, or a transfer of Foundation Recognition Points from a Rotary club, district, or another individual. (Note: gifts to the Endowment Fund are not eligible for Paul Harris Fellow recognition and are not included in this column). For confidentiality reasons, this report will not display recognition amounts greater than 9,000.

Current PHF Level: Recognition levels are determined based on the following guidelines:

Paul Harris Fellow recognition is applicable only to individuals. An organization can be recognized upon the request with a Certificate of Appreciation when its Recognition Amount reaches \$1,000.

PHF Date: Indicates when the account holder became a Paul Harris Fellow.

Foundation Recognition Points: Awarded in appreciation for personal contributions from an individual or organization. Foundation Recognition Points may be transferred to other individuals to help them achieve their first or multiple PHF recognition. Starting in October 2011, points accumulate 1:1 for every dollar contributed (Note: gifts to the Endowment Fund are not eligible for Paul Harris Fellow recognition and are not included in this column).

Last Contribution Date and Designation: Displays month and year of the most recent contribution and indicates the designation (Program Fund). Anonymous contributions are excluded.

Benefactor: Indicates that the individual is a Benefactor.

Rotary: Direct: Indicates individuals who are enrolled in Rotary's recurring giving program (Rotary Direct) on a monthly, quarterly or annual basis.

Benefactor: A Benefactor is anyone who informs the Foundation in writing that s/he has made provisions in their will, or other estate plan, naming the Foundation's Endowment Fund (formally called the Permanent Fund) as a beneficiary; or anyone who makes an outright gift of US1,000 or more to the Foundation's Endowment Fund.

Bequest Society: Individuals who commit US\$1,000 or more to the Rotary Foundation Endowment, via estate plans, are recognized as Bequest Society Members. Bequests from spouses are often combined, upon request. Donors who commit jointly as a couple are counted as a single Bequest Society member on this report. If the spouses are in two different clubs, they will be counted as one on each club's report.

Major Donors/AKS: Major Donors are individuals, non-Rotary affiliated foundations, and corporations whose personal cumulative donations to the Rotary Foundation reach US\$10,000 or more. Contributions from spouses are often combined, upon request. Those whose cumulative donations are US\$250,000 or more are recognized as Arch Klumph Society members (AKS). Spouses who give jointly as a couple are counted as a single Major Donor/AKS Member on this report. If the spouses are in two different clubs, they will be counted as one on each club's report.

The Major Donor, Arch Klumph Society, and Bequest Society Report contains a list of donors who have achieved these substantial giving levels. It is available to club presidents, club secretaries, and club foundation chairs on My Rotary at www.rotary.org/ myrotary, or on Rotary Club Central.

"+": Indicates individual is deceased

"*": Indicates constituents with recognition amounts over 9,000.

Rotary ID: A Constituent's Rotary International identification number. If the constituent is a non-Rotarian or a non-Rotary organization, this is his/her donor account number. An individual should have only one identification number. That number will always contain a Rotarian's membership and contribution history. Duplicate accounts should be reported to The Rotary Foundation as outlined above.

Name: Listed are all constituents associated with Rotary club. Please note that name prefixes and titles do not appear on the report, eq.: Mr./Mrs../Ms.

Club Members: This column state whether the person is a Rotarian in the Rotary club under which his/her name appears. Y=Active Members, H=Honorary Member, N=Non

100% Paul Harris Fellow Club: 100% status is achieved when every member of the club is certified as a Paul Harris Fellow. This is a one-time recognition only. To obtain this recognition a club representative contacts the district governor after determining that all current, dues-paying club members are Paul Harris Fellow. The district governor then confirms that all members are Paul Harris Fellows and notifies The Rotary Foundation.
