#### THE CHARTER MEMBERS

The Rotary Club of Dumaguete South was born out of a vision to become the civic club that could encourage and foster the ideals of genuine service among its members and to demonstrate these in his personal, business and community life.

With the initiative of the late Rtn. Martin "Ting" Matiao and PP Andres "Andy" Ricardo, the RC of Dumaguete helped nurture that dream. Together, they started recruiting leaders in Dumaguete City who would now comprise the RC Dumaguete South. By December 7, 1977, the RC of Dumaguete South got its Chapter approval from Rotary International. It was officially presented to the community on February 12, 1978 by PDG George Royeca and PGGR Quintin "King" Doromal.







Through the years, RCDS has been awarded Rotary International and District Awards being: a) an active supporter in various rural and urban community projects and international project in the eradication of polio; b) a regular contributor to the Rotary Foundation; c) a founder of the two foundations, namely, the Rtn. Martin "Ting" Matiao Foundation, Inc. (TMF) and Rtn. Rajan Dulamal – Rotary Operation Share A Smile Foundation Inc. (ROSAS); and d) a recipient of Matching Grants and World Community Service Funds.

Among the significant awards were Most Outstanding Club of District 386 (now 3860); No. 1 Club of District (Most Improved per capita); Most Outstanding Community Project – SCORE in District 3860, RY 2002 – 2003; Second Outstanding Club Bulletin in Dist. 3860, RY 2004 – 2005; yearly award – Most Outstanding Club, Club President, Club Secretary and Club Bulletin in Zone 3D since RY 2000 – 2001 to RY 2006 – 2007; Most Outstanding President Zone 3D, RY 2011 – 2012 and Most Outstanding Secretary in Zone 3D, Visayas and District 3860 in RY 2011 – 2012.

Among the Matching Grant Funds were for portable water with water tank, at Negros Oriental Provincial Hospital; for school Furniture, Text, and Reference books distributed to Candau-ay, Balugo, Cadawinonan, Babajuba and Herminigilda Elementary Schools; for Rescue Operation for Mathematic Education (ROME) in 18 Dumaguete City Public Elementary schools; for educational assistance to Little Children of the Philippines, Claytown, Daro, Dumaguete City; for purchase of prosthesis, surgical and medical expenses of heart, anus and foot ailments/deformities; vermin-compost projects in Dumaguete City Habitat for Humanity, Inc.; beneficiaries of computer units for Amado Dagodag, South City and Balugo Elementary Schools and Little Children of the Philippines and Mobile Health Clinic turned over to the Dumaguete City LGU; and Computer Projects involving donations and installations of: 49 desktop units at North City Elementary School, 10 desktops at City Public Library located at City Central School, 45 desktops at Magsaysay Elementary School at Dauin, 10 laptops and 3 desktops for the students of Taclobo High School Dumaguete City residing at Little Children of the Philippines, 1 desktop for San Jose Elementary School for deaf pupils and 10 laptop and 3 desktops with 1 projector to the Consuelo Homes Facility.

The World Community Service (WCS) funded projects were Feeding program in Dumaguete City, Vitamin A supplementation, and Playground and Livelihood projects in Calindagan.
