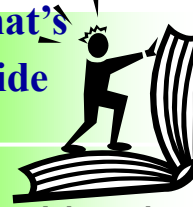

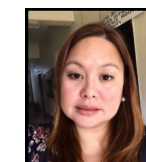


Holy Cross High School has already started its regular classes on July 26, 2021 for this School Year 2021-2022.


Considering the worsening of the Covid-19 Pandemic, face to face classes are still prohibited. We continue to implement two modalities of learning – the modular and the virtual.
