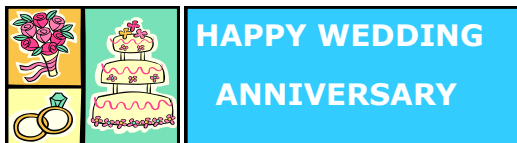

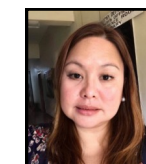

Let's join our hands, there's no reason to divide.

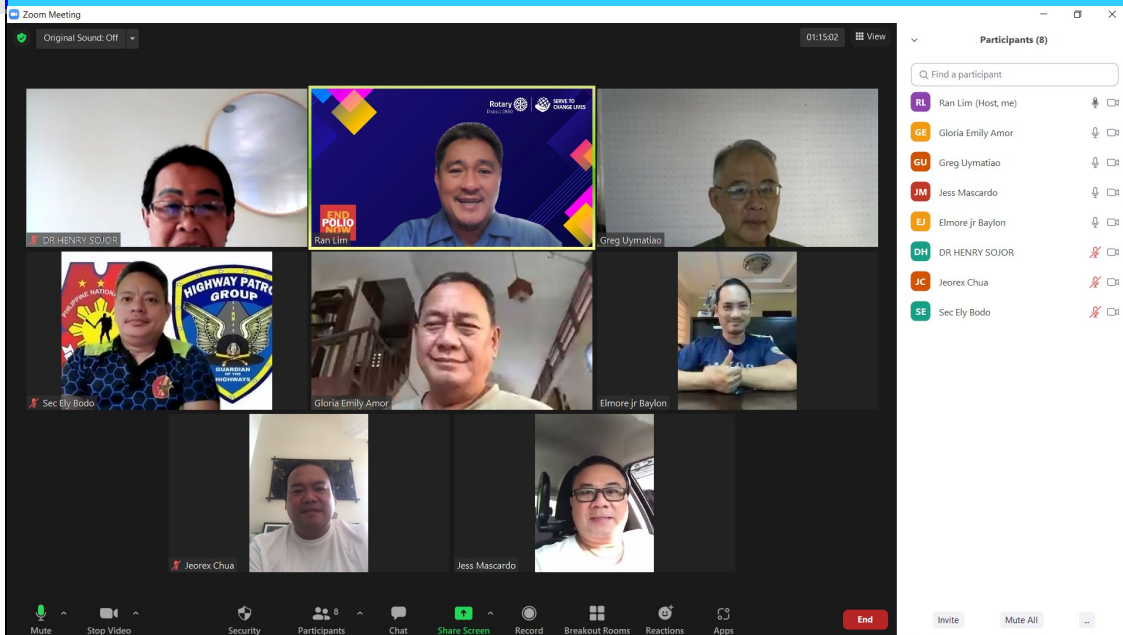

DISTRICT GOALS FOR ROTARY YEAR 2021-22

MANDATORY OBLIGATIONS (Accomplish the TWO):

- Accomplish the Rotary Citation in the Rotary Club Central
- Settle RI Dues, District Dues (District Levy and District Disaster), and the Philippine Rotary Magazine (PRM) or The Rotarian Dues

INCREASE YOUR IMPACT

MANDATORY GOALS:

- Clubs achieve the \$100 per capita club contribution to the Annual Program Fund
The club's total amount of contribution to the Annual Program Fund of TRF should be equal to the total number of members on July 1, 2021 x USD \$100
- Clubs achieve the EREY (Every Rotarian Every Year) goal by requiring each member to contribute USD \$25 or more to the Annual Program Fund.
- Clubs to contribute a minimum of \$200.00 to the PolioPlus Program
- Undertake at least 1 project in each of the Seven Areas of Focus

Achieve at least 3 of 4 Goals:

- Participate in the District-wide "Rotary Days of Service"
 - a. One District, One Bloodletting (July)
 - b. One District, One Mangroves Planting/Coastal Clean-Up OR One District, One Tree Growing (September)
 - c. One District, One Pink October Awareness Campaign (October)
 - d. One District, One Bike to End Polio (November)
 - e. One District, One Autism Awareness Activity (January)
 - f. One Rotary, One Empowering Girls Campaign
 - g. One Philippines COVID19 Vaccination Awareness Campaign
- Pursue your club's "Passion Project" or signature project by partnering with your clubs' RI-registered Rotary Community Corps (RCC) OR with one or more organizations, corporations, government entities, and non-government organizations
- Club president and TRF Chair to become a New Paul Harris Fellow or next level Paul Harris Fellow
- Participate in the **End Polio Now** awareness campaign of the District
