Dear Life-Changing Presidents and Rotarians of District 3860,

Greetings!

The District Nominating Committee (DNC), chaired by IPDG Rodel Riezl S. Reyes, has informed the Office of the District Governor that after a thorough review and deliberation of the three (3) candidates' service records and personal interview last March 26, 2022 via Zoom, the DNC is endorsing Rotarian Caroline Lee Andrade of the Rotary Club of Kandaya-Tacloban as the UNANIMOUS CHOICE for the position of District Governor Nominee Designate.

Please be informed that, as stipulated in the Rotary International Manual of Procedures, pursuant to Article XII, section 12.030.7 - *Challenging Candidates*, "any club in the district which has been in existence for at least one year may propose a **challenging candidate** provided that the club has previously suggested such candidate to the District Nominating Committee (DNC). The name of the challenging candidate shall be submitted by a resolution of the club adopted at a regular meeting and filed with the District Governor by the date set, which shall be within 14 days of notification of the selection for governor-nominee".

Therefore, the deadline for receipt of a resolution passed at a Club's regular meeting naming previously endorsed Rotarian as **challenging candidate** will be on or before **Monday**, **April 11**, 2022.

If **NO** club resolution will be received by this Office on April 11, 2022, the District Governor will declare the unchallenged Rotarian to be the **official District Governor-Nominee Designate.** She will serve her term as District Governor on Rotary Year 2024-25.

However, if a challenge is received by the Office on or before April 11, 2022, an announcement will be made to all the clubs in the District setting the deadline for the receipt of concurrence through CLUB Resolutions adopted at a regular meeting concurring with the challenge.

A valid challenge requires concurrence by either:

- 1. 10 Rotary clubs; or
- 2. **20 percent** of the total number of clubs
 Which have been in existence for at least one year as of the beginning of the year in that district, whichever is higher. (Art. XII Sect. 12.030.8)

The District now has 99 active clubs and **twenty percent** (20%) constitutes 20 Rotary clubs to concur with the challenge. If a valid challenge with twenty (20) Club Resolutions' concurrences are received on or before April 11, 2022, the District Governor will notify all the clubs with the names and qualifications of each candidate as well as the twenty (20) Rotary Clubs that concurred with the challenge.

The District Governor will announce that the selection among these candidates shall be conducted through **electronic-ballot-by-mail** as agreed in RI Board Decision dated June 2020.
