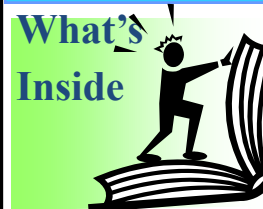

Greetings!

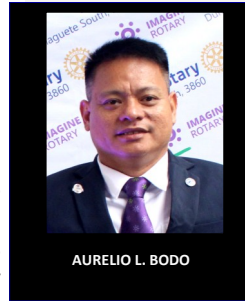
