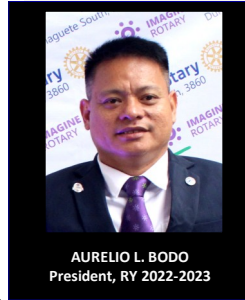


PRESIDENT'S CORNER

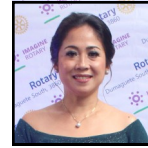

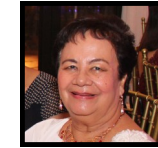

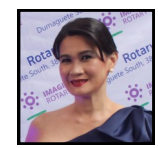
