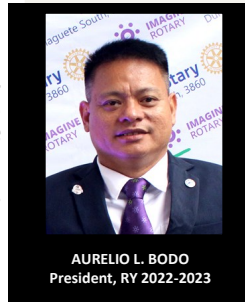


PRESIDENT'S CORNER

Reminding everyone to settle your RI dues.

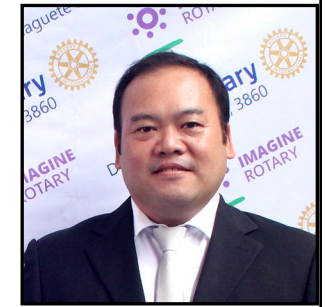
