Teach us, good Lord, to serve Thee as Thou deserves: (in the words of St. Ignati-us Layola)

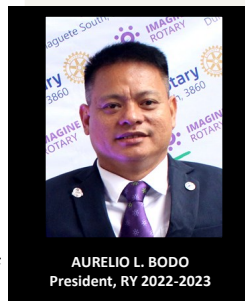
To give and not to count the cost;
