PRESIDENT'S CORNER

Greetings! Today is our 30th Regular Meeting and May is Youth Service Month for Rotary. It is an annual event celebrated by Rotary International during the month of May. It is a time for Rotary clubs around the world to recognize the importance of young people and the role they play in building stronger communities.

Youth Service Month is just one of many ways in which Rotary seeks to empower young people and provide them with the tools they need to make a positive impact in their communities.

During Youth Service Month, Rotary clubs are encouraged to focus on youth-oriented projects and programs. These may include initiatives that promote education, leadership development, and community service. The goal is to inspire young people to become active members of their communities and to help them develop the skills they need to become future leaders.
