Rotary Factoids

In many Rotary clubs throughout the world, wives of male members are affectionately called 'Rotary Anns'.

This designation was never one of disparagement, but rather grew out of an interesting historical occasion.

The year was 1914 when San Francisco Rotarians boarded a special train to attend the Rotary convention being held in Houston. In those days, few wives attended Rotary events, and until the train stopped in Los Angeles, the only woman aboard was the wife of Rotarian Bru Brunnier. As the train picked up, additional convention-bound delegates, Mrs. Ann Brunnier was introduced as a Rotarian's Ann.

This title soon became 'Rotary Ann'.

Since the clubs of the West were inviting the Rotarians to hold their next convention in San Francisco, a number of songs and stunts were organized which would be performed in Houston. One of the Rotarians wrote a "Rotary Ann" chant. On the train's arrival at the Houston depot, a delegation greeted the West Coast Rotarians. One of the greeters was Guy Gundaker of Philadelphia, whose wife was also named Ann.

During the rousing demonstration, someone started the Rotary Ann chant. The two petite ladies, Ann Brunnier and Ann Gundaker, were hoisted on the men's shoulders, and paraded about the hall. The group loved the title given to the two women named 'Ann'. Immediately, the same term of endearment was used for all of the wives of Rotarians in attendance, and since then, the name "Rotary Ann" was here to stay.

Guy Gundaker became president of Rotary International in 1923, and Bru Brunnier was elected president in 1952. Thus, each of the two original Rotary Anns became the "first lady of Rotary International."

In some clubs, the Rotary Anns are considered partner organizations, while others are called "Inner Wheel." As there are clubs that accept women Rotarian members, some insist that the politically-correct term for the wives, or husbands, of Rotarians should be 'Rotary Spouse'.

With our Rotary Club of Dumaguete South being an all-male organization, we prefer to call our respective wives as 'Rotary Anns'. And now you know where it came from. (from *50 Things Every Rotarian should know about Rotary*)

MY NOTES



Our very own Rotarian AVELEX SALINAS AMOR, 'Doki' to family and friends, the firstborn of PP Alex & Ann Boots Amor, was a medical doctor who was known for his crusade against corruption in the medical establishment, and for his service to the poor.

Born in 1975 in Dumaguete City, Rtn. Avelex studied at Silliman University for his basic education, and at the University of the Philippines in Los Baños for college, graduating with a degree in zoology in 1996. He finished his medical degree from the Cebu Institute of Medicine in 2000, and soon earned diplomates in Occupational Health and Diabetes.

He opened a small clinic and a wellness club at the public market of Dumaguete, and served as doctor for poor patients in Siquijor, Dauin, Sta. Catalina, Bindoy, and Canlaon City. He was known for taking out personal loans to buy medicines for his patients.

In August 2018, he was appointed Medical Chief of the Canlaon District Hospital. He instituted systemic changes that curbed long-standing corrupt practices, but was replaced after six days. He was reinstated to the position in September, but was killed by an assassin on 20 November 2018. His murder remains unresolved to this day.

The Amor families have since established the Dr. Avelex S. Amor Fellowship in Medicine at Silliman University to help train new doctors, in honor of his untiring service to the poor. (*Dumaguete Tourism Office*)

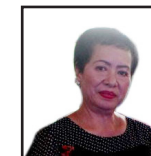
