### Minutes of March 6 meeting:

Pres. Alex Pal called the meeting to order at 6:30 a.m.

1) Rtn. Edo Adriano led the invocation.  
 2) After the Pambansang Awit and the Rotary Hymn, Rtn. Matthew Green recited the Four-Way Test and the Mission and Object of Rotary.

3) Rtn. Nonoy Ligutom led the fellowship singing.

4) PP Ran Lim made an appeal to increase our giving when we are "fined" during the Fine Moments because this collection henceforth will go to the SANO Fund to pay for, among other things, the registration of six of our new Rotarian officers for RY 2024-25 who are now required to participate in the the PETS/SETS and the District Training Assembly (DisTAs) from April 11-13 here in Dumaguete.

9) He then encouraged Rotarians to avail of the \$200 offer of the District to become a Paul Harris Fellow. The District will match the \$200 with 800 points so that the donor will become a Paul Harris Fellow, on condition that the donor will add another \$100 next semester.

10) Some Rotarians have committed to attend the DISCON in Davao City.

### What is a Paul Harris Fellow?

A Paul Harris Fellow is a person who has been recognized as having done something significant for others through a contribution of \$ 1000, which will be spent on humanitarian efforts around the world.

A Paul Harris Fellow is recognized for service to the club and the community.

The recognition is named after Paul Harris, founder and organizer of the first Rotary Club in Chicago in 1905. He was founder of the Rotary idea, and the first president of the worldwide organization, Rotary International.

Upon Paul Harris' death in 1947, memorial gifts poured in to honor the founder of Rotary. From that time, the Rotary Foundation has been achieving the noble objective

of furthering "understanding and friendly relations between peoples of different nations".

In 1957, the idea of the Paul Harris Fellow recognition was first proposed as a means to promote voluntary giving to the Rotary Foundation.

Although the concept of making \$1,000-gifts to the Foundation was slow in developing, by the early 1970s the program began to gain popularity.

The distinctive Paul Harris Fellow medallion, lapel pin, and a certificate have become highly-respected symbols of a substantial commitment to The Rotary Foundation by Rotarians and friends around the world.
