16. PP Ran Lim said he perceives from Pres. Elmore Baylon’s message in the Group Chat that he is under intense pressure and perhaps, accepting his offer to resign will relieve the pressure.
17. IPP Alex moved to accept the apology of Pres. Elmore Baylon, Jr and Sec. Junrex Bungabong, while asking them to refrain from moves that will divide the club.
18. PP Greg Uymatiao, Jr said there is no need for the President and Secretary to resign as they have apolo - gized for their lapses and have promised to prospectively work to accomplish the Club’s goals.
ACTION:
1. TO ACCEPT THE APOLOGY OF PRES. ELMORE BAYLON, JR AND SEC. JUNREX BUNGABONG AND TO RE-MIND THEM TO FOLLOW THE PROTOCOL IN ADMITTING NEW MEMBERS.
2. TO REMIND THE PRESIDENT TO INFORM BODO NOT TO ATTEND CLUB MEETINGS AND EVENTS UNTIL HE RESOLVES HIS DIFFERENCES WITH SOME ROTARIANS BECAUSE IGNORING THIS STEP WOULD NOT BE GOOD FOR THE CLUB.
19. PP Ran Lim discussed how the SANO Fund should be used. When attending seminars, priority should be given to paying the registration. Hotel and travel may be shouldered by the officers if the funds are limited.
20. PE Niño Viking also said that moving forward, there is a need to see the plans of the Club for the Rotary Year. He advised the Pres. and Sec. to post the plans in the Group Chat so we can provide inputs.
21. Pres. Elmore Baylon Jr said they are going to propose a fund-raising activity to finance the Club’s projects. They will provide the details soon.
22. Pres. Elmore Baylon, Jr. also said on July 27, we will have a joint bloodletting program with the Rotary Club of Dumaguete North. Communications have already been sent to the Red Cross Administrator and the Chairman.

3. THE BOARD AGREED THAT THE PRESIDENT AND SECRETARY WILL PRESENT PROPOSALS TO THE BOARD PRIOR TO ANY ACTIVITY OR CLUB PROJECT.

23. IPP Alex Rey Pal also mentioned that Dir. Ronael Fungo called him to say he is on schooling in Cebu on weekdays and may not be able to function as Club Membership Director. Pres Elmore Baylon, Jr. suggested that Rtn. Ponciano Ligutom be appointed Ast. Club Director for Membership

24. PP Ran Lim informed Pres. Elmore that he is expected to attend the vibrant Club Seminar in Cebu on August 17, while he, IPP Alex Pal and PE Niño Viking will attend a meeting with the Rotary International President-Elect in Manila on August 20, 2024.
25. Treas. Jessie reminded the Board that our collection efforts for our Semestral Dues are still below 50 percent. He also discussed other financial housekeeping matters.
26. There being no other matters, the meeting adjourned at 10:23 a.m.

MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL BOARD MEETING OF THE
ROTARY CLUB OF DUMAGUETE SOUTH
6:30 A.M. JULY 16, 2024 DCCCO HOTEL

- Pres. Elmore called the meeting to order at 7:13 a.m.
- 1) Pres. Elmore started the meeting by saying he is offering to resign as President after he added the name of PP Ely Bodo to the membership of RC Dumaguete South without following the proper procedure outlined in the Constitution and By-Laws.
 - 2) IPP Alex Pal said the Constitution and By-Laws are specific in that a person cannot be admitted as a member of the Club without the approval of the Board. Even one objection is enough to disqualify a Baby Rotarian. IPP Alex also reminded Pres. Elmore that in previous Board Meetings, he was made aware of this rule and was directed to inform PP Ely Bodo not to attend Rotary meetings until he had reached out and mended friendships with some Club members.
 - 3) Pres. Elmore said he and Sec. Junrex thought admitting PP Ely Bodo was a good idea because he had promised to support his administration and attend meetings. He apologized for his decision.
 - 4) Pres. Elmore backtracked from their decision to admit PP Ely Bodo to the club last July 10 and returned the money he gave as membership dues.
 - 5) Pres. Elmore clarified that as of today, PP Ely Bodo is not a member of the Club.
 - 6) Exec. Sec. Boy Diputado stated: "that the case of PP Ely Bodo is different from other Rotarians who absented themselves for more than the required number of attendance. As per record he voluntarily resigned from the club and the RI itself. If he wants to rejoin, PP Ely Bodo may follow the procedure set up under our constitutions and by-laws. Personally I know PP Ely Bodo has served well and contributed much to the community thru Rotary in the past years."
 - 7) Dir. Randy Quisil said because we are all friends, we do not want factions in the Club.
 - 8) PP Ran Lim said there is no need for the President to unite the club because the Club is united. The Club's unity is the main reason why we were able to raise a big amount during the Victory Party last May.
 - 9) PP Ran Lim said this process should be done outside of Rotary as friendships are spontaneous.
 - 10) President-Elect Niño Viking said while he cannot make a comment against anyone, he hopes issues will be resolved through the procedures outlined in the Constitution and By-Laws.
 - 11) IPP Alex Pal said the root of all these problems is the insistence of Pres. Elmore Baylon to add PP Ely Bodo the Club despite instructions from the Board to inform PP Ely Bodo not to attend meetings until he has repaired friendships with people he had issues with.
 - 12) Another viewpoint was shared by VP Ashley Morelos, who said he had a meeting with Ely Bodo. VP Ashley Morelos said PP Ely Bodo told him he was ok that he is not anymore a member of Rotary. VP Ashley Morelos said PP Ely Bodo told him that he doesn't have to worry about producing money to pay for his semestral dues and attend meetings. PP Ely Bodo said it was Pres. Elmore Baylon who is insistent that he rejoin the club, visiting him at his house late at night bringing drinks to convince him to return to the Club.
 - 13) Pres. Elmore Baylon reiterated his offer to resign and he and Sec. Junrex Bungabong also offered their apologies.
 - 14) Sec. Junrex Bungabong said it was not Pres. Elmore Baylon's intention to resign. He is losing P20,000 to P30,000 a day by not attending to his clinic and he, too, is losing money by doing Rotary work. Pres. Elmore Baylon and Sec. Junrex Bungabong said they are still very willing to serve as Rotary Club officers and vowed to serve until the end of their terms.
 - 15) PP Ran Lim said all Presidents and Secretaries go through the same pressure and no one has since complained about it because being away from one's work is expected when one serves in Rotary. He said it is not healthy to say we lost money by serving as Rotary President.
