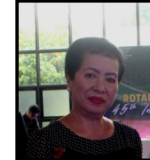

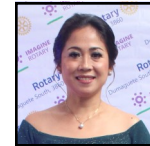

PRESIDENT'S CORNER

We've been through tough times. Just last week, on September 30, 2025 at 9:59 PM, a strong 6.9-magnitude earthquake struck the northern part of Cebu, particularly in areas like Bogo City, Medellin, and nearby towns. Sadly, many lives were lost and countless families were displaced. Here in Negros Oriental, we also felt the tremor at around 5.2 magnitude, which caused fear but, thankfully, minimal damage.

As of today, many concerned citizens — bloggers, private individuals, and even foreigners — have extended their help to the affected communities. And as Rotarians, it is also our duty to serve and bring hope in times of crisis. Through our Rotary Club of Dumaguete South (RCDS) and individual efforts, we can make a significant impact on the lives of the earthquake victims in North Cebu.

On October 2, 2025, at 6:00 PM, we held an emergency Zoom meeting, which I presided over, to address this urgent matter. During the meeting, everyone unanimously approved the release of ₱30,000 from our Club's Calamity Fund to be deposited to the District 3860 Disaster Management Inc. account. This fund will be used to purchase priority needs for the earthquake victims. This act of giving truly reflects the Rotary spirit of compassion and service above self.

This month is filled with meaningful activities, and we must stay focused and united in fulfilling them. The Rotary Club of Dumaguete North will be launching a Pickleball Tournament on October 11, 2025, as a Fundraising and Friendly Games event. Let us show our support and participation to our fellow Rotarians in this worthwhile activity.

We also remind everyone about the upcoming TRF (The Rotary Foundation) Contribution, which is due on October 15, 2025. Those who will give will be recognized during the TRF Night on November 8, 2025. I encourage every member to take part in this noble cause, as every contribution helps strengthen Rotary's global mission of service and sustainability.

Moreover, the Rotary Club of Dumaguete has invited us, the Rotary Club of Dumaguete South, to be co-hosts of the 2nd Annual "Run to End Polio" on Sunday, October 19, 2025. Let's join this run with enthusiasm and pride, as it supports Rotary International's mission to eradicate polio worldwide. The proceeds will go to The Rotary Foundation and the PolioPlus Society — a reminder that every step we take brings the world closer to a polio-free future.

There will also be another exciting event, the "Surf to End Polio", on October 25, 2025, to be held at Cangmating Beach, Sibulan. A committee meeting will soon be announced to ensure proper coordination and finalization of the event details.

Let us continue to uphold the true meaning of Rotary Service — working together with purpose, compassion, and unity. I hope everyone remains well, inspired, and ready to serve our community with dedication and heart.

Rotary information: 24th of October World Polio Day



Rotary has been working to eradicate polio more than 35 years. Our goal of ridding the world of this disease is closer than ever.

As a founding partner of the Global Polio Eradication Initiative, we've reduced polio cases by 99.9 percent since our first project to vaccinate children in the Philippines in 1979.

Rotary members have contributed more than \$2.1 billion and countless volunteer hours to protect nearly 3 billion children in 122 countries from this paralyzing disease. Rotary's advocacy efforts have played a role in decisions by governments to contribute more than \$10 billion to the effort.

Today, polio remains endemic only in Afghanistan and Pakistan. But it's crucial to continue working to keep other countries polio-free. If all eradication efforts stopped today, within 10 years, polio could paralyze as many as 200,000 children each year.
