RCDS Supports Community Development in iHome–Metro Dumaguete Area in Dadawinonan

The Rotary Club of Dumaguete South (RCDS) has initiated a Community Development Support Program for the iHome–Metro Dumaguete housing community in Barangay Cadawinonan, Dumaguete City, in partnership with iHome–Metro Dumaguete, the College of Agriculture of Foundation University, and the Friendly Homes Association (FHA).

The FHA, composed of 26 beneficiary families, is the homeowners' association of the iHome housing project and the primary beneficiary of the program. As part of the initiative, Foundation University students conducted a community survey during the third quarter of last year to establish a community profile and identify priority development needs.

The results of the survey were presented and validated during a community workshop held on December 29, 2025. On the same occasion, a Memorandum of Agreement was signed by the four partner institutions, formalizing their collaboration for the sustainable development of the housing community.

Based on the validated findings, key recommendations focused on livelihood enhancement, maternal and child health, housing security, education support, leadership development, and improvement of basic services.

During its January Board Meeting, RCDS approved concrete support for the program, including ₱20,000 in seed capital for livelihood initiatives and ₱32,000 for maternal and child health interventions. The Club also opened the possibility of the Friendly Homes Association becoming a future recipient of a garbage vehicle donation, subject to further evaluation.

To generate additional service funds, RCDS will hold a fundraising sports event this month dubbed the “iDink Pickleball Tournament to Generate Service Fund,” with proceeds earmarked for the FHA Community Development Support Program.

This initiative reflects RCDS's continuing commitment to evidence-based, partnership-driven community development in line with Rotary's Areas of Focus.
