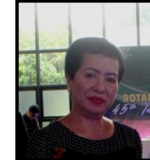

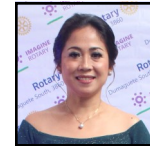

You serve your club and all its members when you take time to attend meetings, work on committees, and promote Rotary's ideals through club projects and activities.

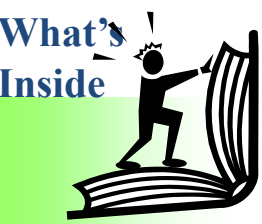

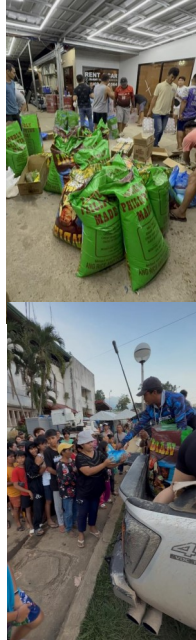

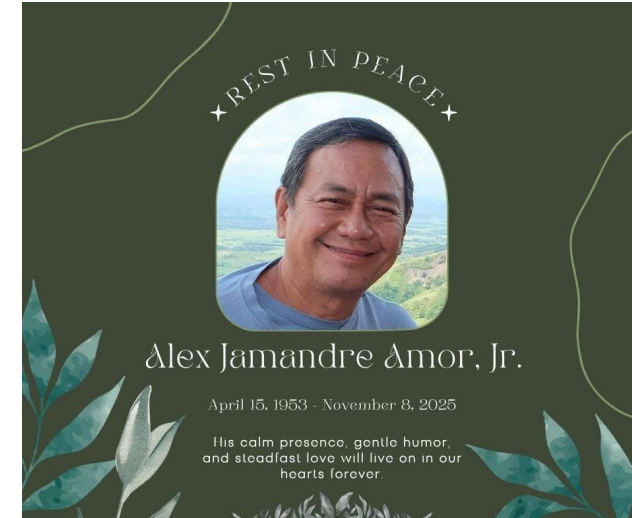
