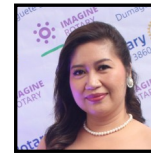

I was then introduced as an international guest and I extended my greetings and introduced our Rotary Club—the earliest Rotary Club to meet in the whole world!

They had many guests that day, students and their parents and teachers who were awarded scholarships. Their club has produced seven District Governors, one of whom—PDG Surinder Sethi (2015-2016)—I met.

The second club met later in the afternoon. Aptly called the Sunset Rotary Club of Bloomington/Normal, they meet for snacks on Wednesdays at 5:15 p.m. They, too, greeted me as I was walking toward them. Being a small club, I talked to everyone before President Gabe Nege rang the bell. They still asked me to say something after I was formally introduced.

They had a guest who spoke through zoom. It gave me an idea for our club.

I was given a banner but after the meeting (and after the photo was taken), the club founder asked for it back, saying they only had three banners left.
