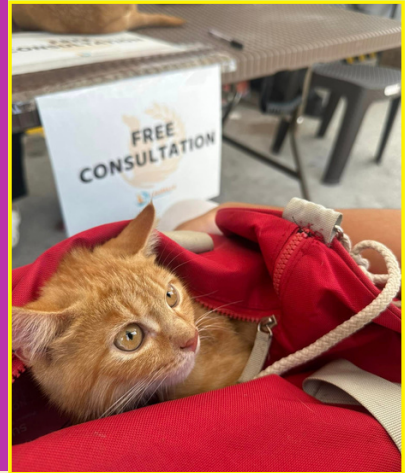

Acknowledging the importance of family support, the event also recognized the active involvement of Greater Ladies' spouses and family members, who contributed to the evening's success.

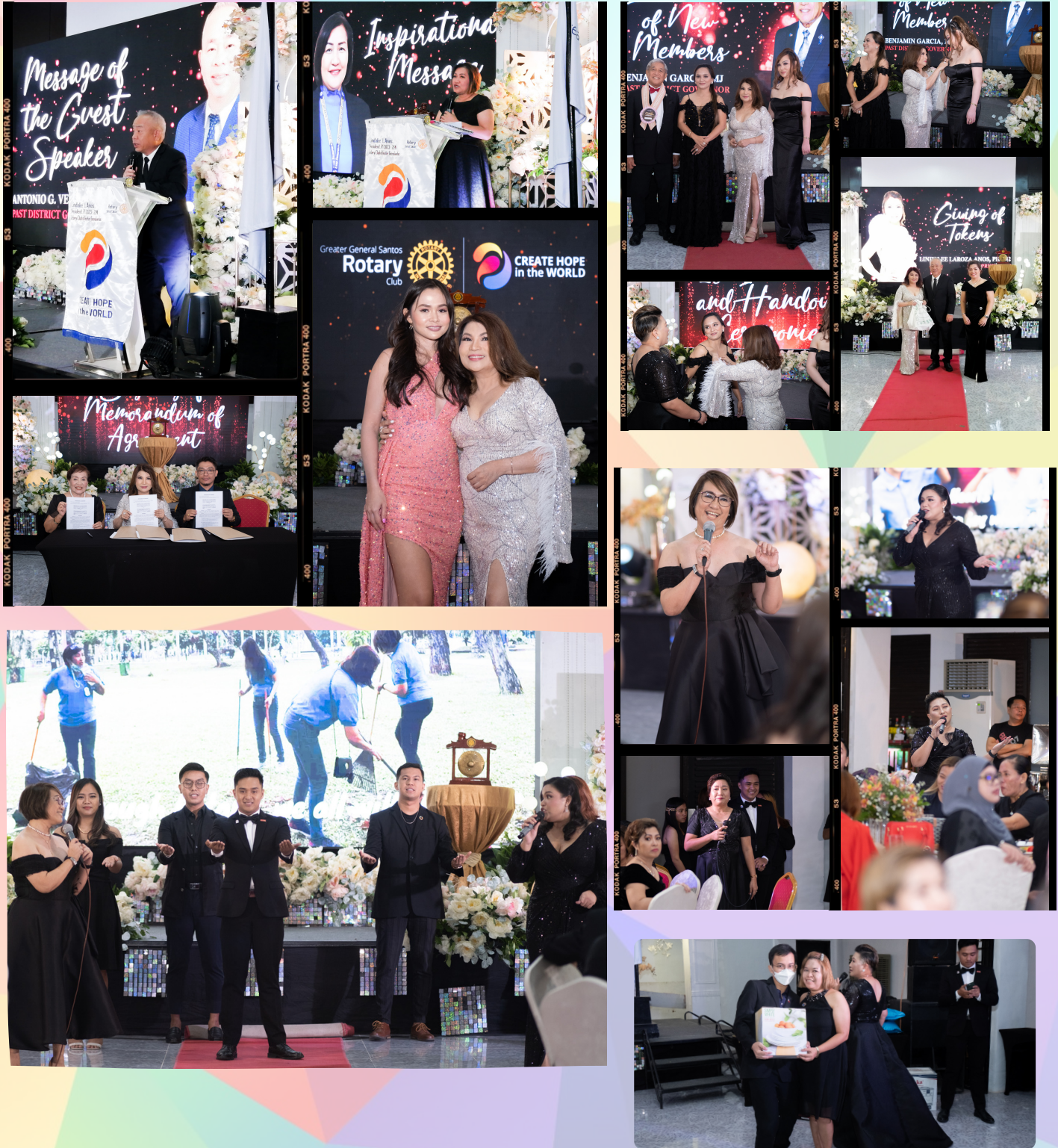
