September is Education and Literacy Month. We have scheduled the distribution of A4 Bond papers to our school recipients this September 24, 2020 at the Rotary Center. The month of October will be a very busy one for all Rotarians. There is the Breast Cancer and Awareness Campaign of RC Kandaya and the Community and Economic Development of RC Central Tacloban. RC Kandaya, being the lead club for the Breast Cancer, will be setting up an awareness booth at the Robinson's North . So that more women will be informed about Breast Cancer, the different clubs of Area 3 B will go to the different Barangay Health Centers to give posters and flyers. Another activity is to put up standees of Breast Cancer Awareness Campaign at selected government and private offices. These will be lent to us by Treasurer Caroline Andrade.

RC Central is the lead club for the Community and Economic Development. Their project is providing abaca seedlings to a community in Burauen, Leyte.

October 24 is also World Polio Day. Pledges of around US\$2,000.00 for our End Polio Program were solicited among the members. Our generous donors are Rotarian Vicky Esber, Treasurer Caroline Andrade, Secretary Kathleen Quintero, Director Miranda Varon, Past president Elvie Casal, Director Cathy Bonavitacola, Rotarian Shyrell Bulkhalter and President Lolit EScano. Thank you ladies for your support of a worthwhile project.

We are very excited about the donation of US\$5,000.00 from the Association of Taclobanons of Southern California, coursed through our Vice President, Marlyn Ruiz. Our Public Image Director, Cathy Bonavitacola, proposed that we put up a mini library and activity center at the Northern Barangay.

Our $3^{\rm rd}$ Board Meeting was held on September 2, 2020 through Zoom. There was a quorum with 10 directors present. The following topics were discussed during the meeting.

- 1. The Philippine Eagle Foundation requested for support to the forest guards by way of gears, supplies, and accident insurance. There was a motion to defer support due to lack of funds. The motion was seconded and approved.
- 2. Distribution of A4 Bond papers to schools who requested. The letter request came from various schools and coursed through our Kandayan members: 1. Bayanihan School PP Flor Lelis 2. Don Vicente Quintero School Sec. Kathleen Quintero 3.. Banez Elementary School, Rtn. Philfa de la Cruz, 4. Sagkahan High School PE Irish Loteyro, 5. Northern Brgy High School Pres. Lolit Escano and Pawing Central School. Those schools were not included on the 1st batch of schools who were previously given on the Area 3B joint project. It was also suggested that we give to each school only 20 reams.
- 3. A good project which could make an impact, mentioned by Treas. Caroline Andrade, was the project of RC Kankabato, "LOKAL WIFI", set up at the Judge Antonio Montilla Elem School in Abucay. She suggested that we meet with Pres. Allan of RC Kankabato, if he is willing to share and help us adopt this project for our club.
- 4. According to Treasurer Caroline Andrade, we can get additional funding for our project from the District from US\$2,000.00 up to a maximum of US\$4,000.00.
- For the Hand washing project, Dir. Miranda Varon will coordinate with Dir. Annabelle Vy for her donations of five to six plastic drums. We just have to identify the recipients.
