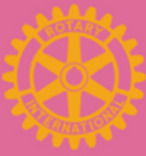

EDITOR'S NOTE

Water and Sanitation

The Philippines is a signatory of the 2030 Agenda and the 17 Sustainable Development Goals (SDG). Goal No. 6 of the SDGs is: Clean Water and Sanitation. Included In the Rotary's Seven Areas of Strategic Focus is Water & Sanitation. While substantial progress has been made in increasing access to dean drinking water and sanitation, billions of people still lack these basic services. Worldwide, one in three people do not have access to safe drinking water, two out of five do not have a basic hand-washing facility with soap and water, and more than 673 million people still practice open defecation.

The COVID 19 pandemic has demonstrated the critical Importance of sanitation, hygiene and adequate access to water for preventing and containing disease. Hand hygiene saves lives. According to WHO, hand-washing is one of the most effective to reduce the spread of pathogens and prevent infections, including COVOD 19 virus. Recognizing this, It is with pride that we have included in this publication, the Rotary Club of Kandaya's (RCK) project on Hand washing. Yet, we know we need to continue to work hard on this area of focus, as billions of people still lack safe water and sanitation, and funding is inadequate.

Clean water is a human right! And this right is duly supported by RCK as consistently demonstrated in its various community service projects. Kandayans' involvement in water and sanitation projects is a continuing rediscovery of our relevance and the essence of our timeless motto, Service Above Self.
