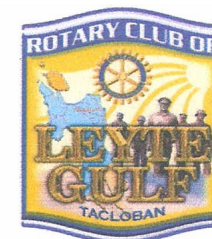

In the Rotary Year 2002-2003, District Governor Pabs Quianzon challenged GSE Alumni Vangie Esperas and Emy Portula Sescon to organize a new Rotary Club in Tacloban. The duo accepted said challenge. DG Pabs assigned District Secretary Buddy Estudillo of RC San Juanico as a Special Governor's Representative for Extension to handle the organization a said new club. With the core group of Vangie and Emy, the first orientation meeting took place, followed by a series of seminars with the assistance of DS Buddy Estudillo.

The fourth club in Tacloban City the RC of Leyte Gulf was formed, with its Charter President Vangie Esperas and Secretary Emy Portula Sescon. The other charter members were Attorney Daniel Matriano, Attorney Jerry Uy, Attorney Leslie Adolfo, Ralph Salazar, Babes Custodio, Massey Grafiel, Molong Bernaldes, Joey Clarin, Kokoy Liao, Entong Yu, Imelda Laceras, Dr. Lesmes Lumen, and Treasurer Cora Nicolasora among others.

Among the achievements of RC Leyte Gulf are attaining 100% Paul Harris Club in Rotary Year 2006-07 (the First 100& PH Club in the Zone and the second in the District) and Outstanding Rotary Club in the Zone on the same year with Rotarian Ralph Salazar as their President, garnering the Outstanding President during the term of District Governor Fernando "Jun" Almeda.

The Charter presentation and induction of Charter Officers and Directors of RC Leyte Gulf was on April 31, 2003 during the Governorship of Pabs Quianzon.
