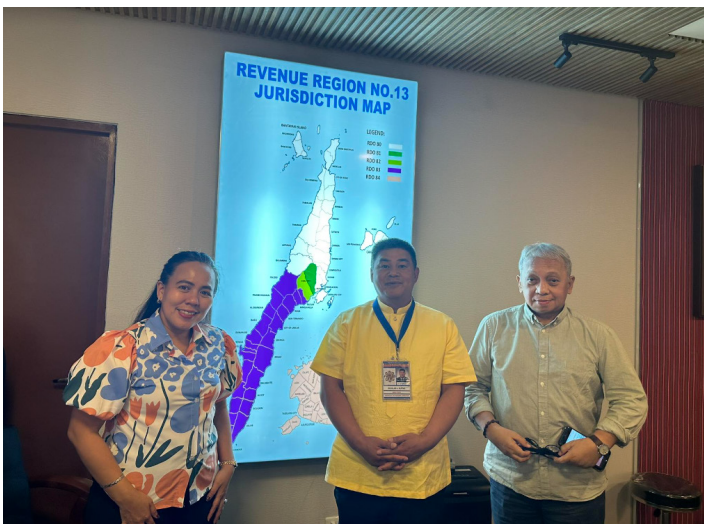
# RCMC Partners In Service

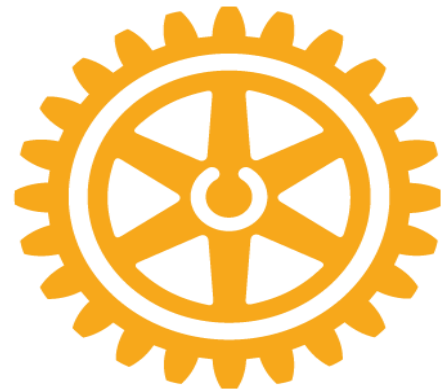
