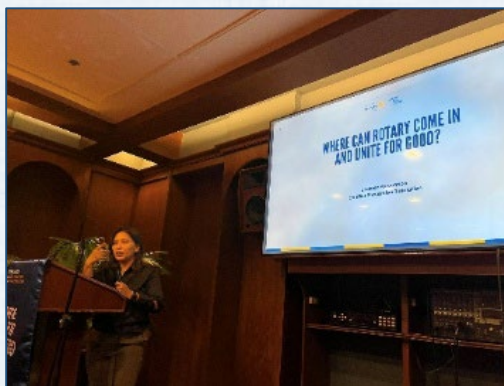

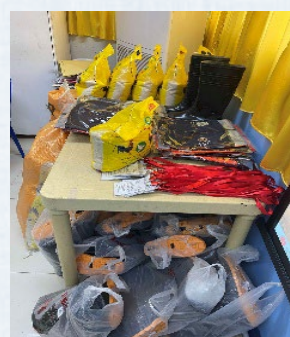

RCMC Launches Empower 360 NEWS (North, East, West, South) Barangay Carreta Dengue Eradication Program (06 & 09 Aug. 2025)

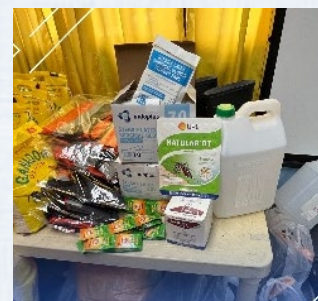
On **August 6, 2025**, the Rotary Club of Metro Cebu (RCMC) proudly launched its **Empower 360 Dengue Program** in partnership with the **Cebu City Health Department, Barangay Carreta officials**, and the passionate **Carreta Dengue Warriors** at the **Barangay Carreta Hall**.



The project was spearheaded by **Dr. Wyben Briones**, alongside **RCMC President Atty. Evelyn Trani** and **President-elect Elcasmer Acedo**, who emphasized that dengue prevention is not just a medical issue but a whole-of-community concern.



In a meaningful turnover ceremony, RCMC formally handed over larvicide (Natular and Sumilarv), Dengue Warrior uniforms, and identification badges to **Barangay Captain Marciano Ando**. These tools and supplies were given to strengthen Carreta's fight against dengue and empower its local volunteers to become true champions of public health.

The presence of **Cebu City Health Officer Dr. Daisy Sariego Villa**, **Dengue Program Coordinator Dr. John Uy**, and **Assistant Coordinator Dr. Marge Tejano** further highlighted the launch. Their attendance reaffirmed the Cebu City Health Department's dedication to sustained dengue prevention and underscored the importance of uniting health authorities, barangay officials, and civic organizations in this vital cause.



Only days later, on **August 9**, the program's operational rollout came to life with **"Dengue Warriors in Action!"** the first community activity under the initiative. A total of **25 Dengue Warriors**, guided by **Captain Ando** and **Barangay Councilor Rhodora Pyls**, put their training and resources to work. Organized under the **NEWS (North, East, West, South) Barangay Carreta Dengue Eradication Program**, the volunteers, proudly wearing their new vests and badges, marched out with boots, IDs, and larvicide in hand.

They went house to house applying larvicide, engaging families in health education, conducting community clean-up drives, and distributing safety kits to households.
