
## **RCMC'S 3rd General Membership Meeting for 2026 (04 Feb. 2026)**

More than collection points for plastic waste, these bins advance environmental stewardship, support livelihood opportunities for Persons Deprived of Liberty, and reinforce advocacy efforts to end Violence Against Women and Children.



Strategically placed in high-foot-traffic areas within the church compound, the project encourages responsible waste disposal while creating pathways for dignity, reintegration, and social impact.

This initiative reflects Rotary's commitment to sustainable service — demonstrating how practical solutions, strong partnerships, and collective action can turn everyday participation into lasting benefit for the community.


