Rotary's World Polio Day Program Looks Toward Polio Eradication's Endgame

Rotary's goal of ridding the world of polio is within reach. So far in 2021, only two cases of wild polio have been reported -- the lowest circulation of the disease ever -- with one infection each in Afghanistan and Pakistan, the two countries where polio remains endemic.

The low case count can be attributed to several factors. These include polio vaccination campaigns resuming after the interruption caused by the COVID-19 pandemic, the natural immunity induced by the wild polio outbreaks of the previous years, and the restrictions on travel and population movement that also were due to the pandemic.

This year, the Global Polio Eradication Initiative (GPEI) announced a new five-year strategy for 2022-26 to end all polio viruses, including tackling the persistent transmission of circulating vaccine-derived poliovirus.

Rotary and our GPEI partners identified remaining obstacles to polio eradication and developed approaches to reaching the goal. The plan aims to achieve and sustain a polio-free world through a focus on implementation and accountability while using innovative methods and tools.
