We also recently celebrated the 121st Anniversary of Rotary through our club fellowship activity "Fun & Fellowship by the Sea" held at Kontiki Resort in Mactan. Members gathered with their families for a day of meaningful connection and celebration—sharing food, enjoying water activities, and strengthening the friendships that fuel our passion for Service Above Self.
