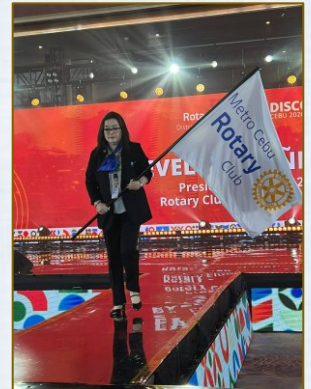

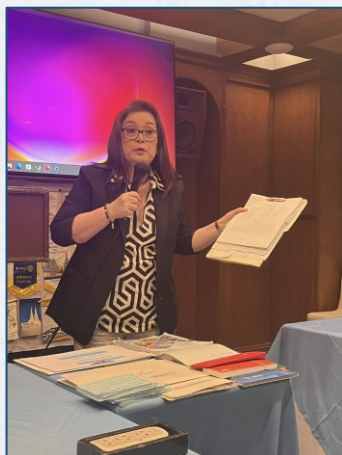
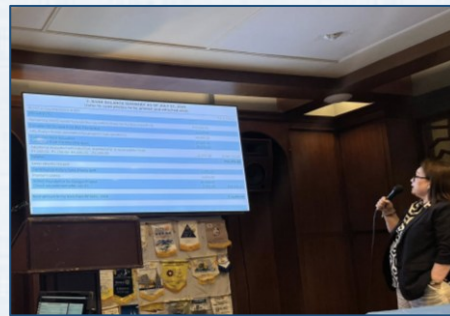
RCMC'S General Membership Meeting – Financial Reporting **(03 June 2026)**
