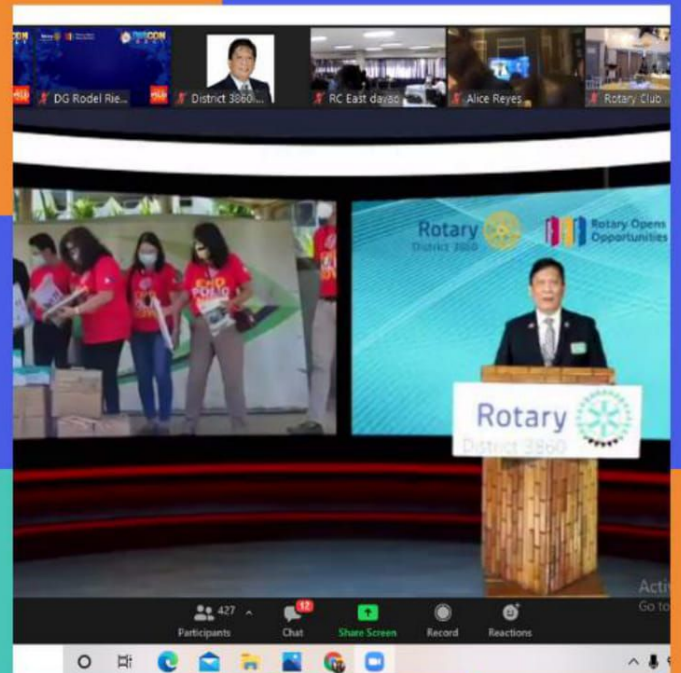

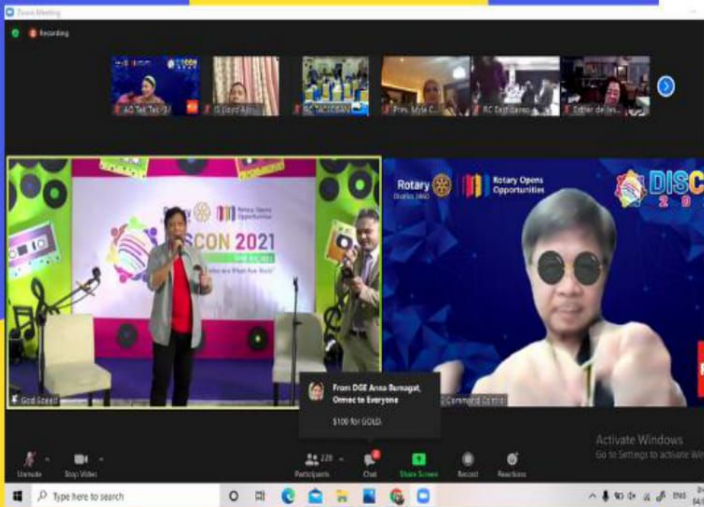

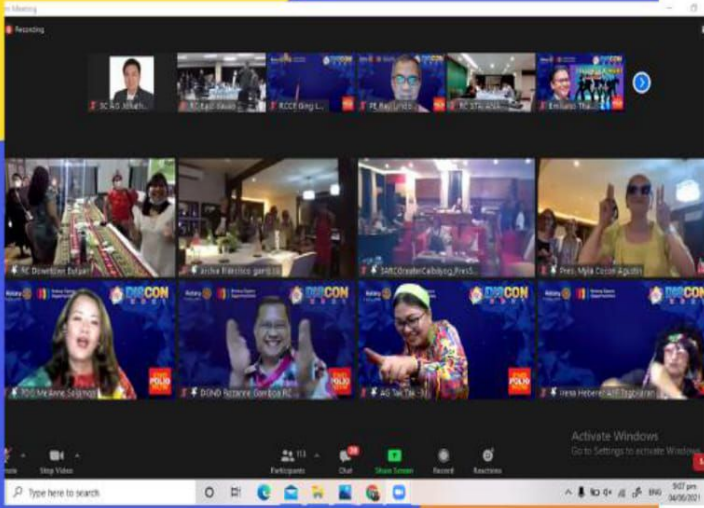


1st Day of DISCON 2021

The event opened with a presentation of club presidents. This is followed by series of talks featuring international and local guest speakers.



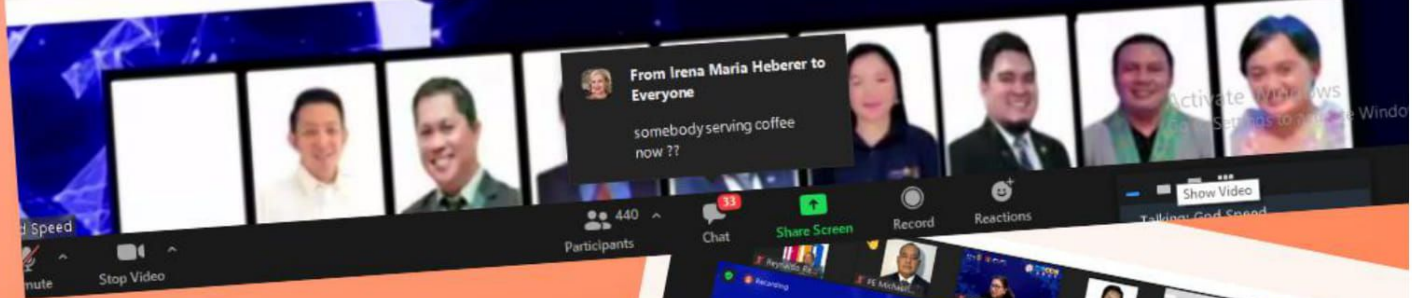
