Turnover of Table Top Water Dispenser with Gallons and Faucets

Aupagan , Butuan City

Brgy. Aupagan's water isn't suitable for drinking. It is infested with blood flukes (parasitic worms carried by snails) from the genus Schistosoma that caused the Schistosomiasis disease. The principal of Aupagan Elementary School, Mr. Louie Jim Payda, mentioned during the turnover of books and reading materials last July that they need table top dispensers and gallons for the classrooms and offices for their safe drinking water. They get safe drinking water from nearby water refilling station.

RCMB fulfilled its promise to provide the need of the school. Seven table top dispensers with gallons were given to the school. The club also added four faucets for their existing handwash facility. The turnover activity was attended by ten Midtowners, one Rotarian spouse, and three Rotaractors.
