Last December 23, 2021, the first major activity of the Rotary District 3860 Disaster Management, Inc.


It was a great success because of the help, support and cooperation of all our members and volunteers.

100 households were given a food packs and 5 galloons of water each at Surigao del Norte High School Evacuation Center, Surigao City . The distribution of food packs was spearheaded by Disaster Management Chair Archie Francisco Gamboa, PAG Bing Garcia, together with DGN Twinkle Gamboa and volunteers Rotarians, Rotarian spouses, Rotaractors of District 3860 in partnership with PNP National Police. The school received also a portable generator set and 3 bulbs solar light.
