
### Your Gift of Reading, My Learning - RCMB Signature Project
















CLUB MEETING: 16th Regular Meeting


The meeting was adjourned at around 9:00 pm.


After the turnover, the Midtowners had a luncheon fellowship in Mahigalaon Beach Resort in which the owner is also a Rotarian.


