An avid supporter of The Rotary Foundation since 2006 when she became a Paul Harris Society member prior to becoming a Rotarian, DG Caycay and Spouse Bobby, are Major Donors Level 4 with a named endowment fund.

In the community, she is a brand ambassador as "Mrs. McDonalds" being the first franchisee to open the first restaurant in Tacloban City. To date, she has grown her business in the region and operates several restaurants. Her management style has been recognized through the years and has garnered her numerous awards and recognitions. 
